For those who perhaps have not met me, or don't know me well - please come and introduce yourselves!- I'm a 23 year old, I grew up in Yorkshire and have just completed an undergraduate degree in agriculture. I live on

Easter Road with a flatmate and spend most of my free time either with a book, on a bike or working on my DIY projects.

- I wanted to spend a year with an eldership who can help me to discern whether I am called to the ministry, who will talk with me and pray for me.

- The spiritual needs of Easter Road, as a resident, have encouraged me to think about local church work and the ways that the community and the church can relate to one another.

I'm looking forward to the role, working with Joe and Liz and thinking about the gospel needs of the place that we as a church have been put. My one ask for the church family would be that they remember me in prayer, particularly praying that I am wise and godly as I consider the future.

#### Assisted Suicide Bill – The Call for Evidence

The <u>call for evidence</u> launched by the Scottish Parliament's Health Committee in June, as part of its scrutiny of Liam McArthur's assisted suicide bill, **closes on Friday 16 August**. Individuals and organisations are invited to express their views; Care Not Killing are encouraging us all to respond.

The Committee has published both a short survey and a detailed call for evidence. The <u>short survey</u> requires answers to only four questions. The <u>detailed call for evidence</u> comprises eight substantive questions and considers the proposed legislation from all perspectives. This is perhaps best suited to those responding on the basis of professional or personal experience, or with intimate knowledge of the evidence base. Care Not Killing have produced a <u>guide</u> to responding to the detailed call for evidence.

#### Summer Appeal 2024




